Vendor invitation and information

This is the first annual Fall Fair in our beautiful historic city, and represents the beginning of the new San Juan Committee's public outreach and fundraising efforts. We are actively working with our local nonprofit organizations and downtown business community to promote economic development while maintaining the historical character and charm of San Juan Bautista.

Please join us for a festive day in the beautiful City of History.

Fees: Show premiere special rates apply for 2011:
\$60.00 for 15 x 10 regular vendor booth space
\$100.00 for food vendor 15 x 10 booth space

Fall Fair Regulations:

1. Event Set-Up Time: 5:00 a.m.
2. All vendors must show proof of registration prior to entering the show street to set-up at assigned booth space.
3. Unloading for booth set up: Please park as close to assigned space as possible on the left hand side of the street.
4. Vendor Vehicles: All vendor vehicles must be removed from the show streets by 9:15 a.m.
5. Vendor Possessions: Vendor back stock, packing boxes, chairs, tables, etc. must be cleared from show sidewalks, as per the San Benito County Fire Code.
6. Vendor End-of-Show Vehicle Re-entry: All vendors must be repacked prior to bringing the vendor's vehicle on the show street for loading.
7. Volunteer block captains will issue a re-entry pass to vendors only when they have determined you are sufficiently repacked.
8. Again, please park as close to your assigned space as possible on the left hand side of the street when you are admitted to reload.

9. The San Juan Committee and its volunteers are not responsible for unloading or loading any vendor items or props.
10. Volunteer Block Captains will control the number of vehicles accessing the event area with view to keeping our vendors, guests and residents safe.

Other:

No refunds will be given for any reason.

All exhibitors are required to stay-up during the entire show. Display areas must be kept neat and clean at all times.

A trash dumpster will be available, and trash cans will be consistently emptied during the course of the show.

The San Juan Committee will have Sheriff's department presence, however we do not guarantee the safety of vendor merchandise.

There will be no postponement of the Fair due to weather or other conditions.

The San Juan Committee reserves the right to make last minute changes for the safety of guests as well as to accommodate vendors. We also reserve the right to expel anyone from the event for disruptive or inappropriate behavior.
